
Duration and Dates

The Mastery Course spans a focused 8-week period.

Starting date: Saturday, April 20th, 2024

End Date: Friday, June 14th, 2024.

This timeframe is planned to ensure a comprehensive and immersive learning experience, allowing you to fully engage with and absorb the rich curriculum we offer.







Course Fees

The total fee for the course is AED 19,450

This fee covers the tuition, full access to our state-of-the-art machines and power tools, and all the necessary materials for projects undertaken during the course.

Students will have a choice of high-quality timber, including Pine, Meranti, Beech, Maple, Ash, and Mahogany.

Hand Tools Purchase: At the beginning of the course, students are required to have the following hand tools as personal property:

- Set of chisels (Western or Japanese)
- Japanese Dozuki hand saw
- Block plane
- Precision square
- Marking gauge
- Marking knife
- Ruler
- Combination square

Students of the Mastery Course, are entitled to a 10% discount on the retail price of these tools if they decide to buy them from The Makers Society. This discount will also extend to future purchases.

Class Schedule

During the weekdays, from Tuesday to Friday, we offer you the flexibility of 16 hours per week of workshop access, where you will be assisted in your development by our expert tutors.

On specific weekdays, there will be dedicated appointments to review the topics that were taught during the previous weekend.

Access to the workshop during the week can be booked anytime between 9 am to 8 pm, according to your convenience. It's a great chance for you to apply your newfound skills, experiment, and refine your techniques in a hands-on environment.

For students who are unable to utilize their workshop time during the week, we provide the option to carry forward up to a maximum of 32 hours of workshop time after the course concludes.

Payment Terms

To secure your place in the course, a deposit of AED 6,000 is required at the time of registration.

The remaining balance of the fee will be split in two parts.

The first 50% is to be paid no later than April 1st, 2024

The remaining 50% is to be paid no later than April 13th, 2024.

Terms and Conditions

- The total fee for the course is AED 19,450. This fee covers the tuition, full access to our state-of-the-art machines and power tools, and all the necessary materials
- for projects undertaken during the course. For those who register before March 13th, we offer a special early bird fee of AED 18,250.
- Hand Tools are not included in the course and it is the responsibility of the student to start the course with a minimum set of hand tools. Students that will buy hand tools from The Makers Society, will be entitled to a 10% discount that will be extended also to future purchases.
- Payments: the payment of the tuition fee is divided into three installments. A deposit of AED6,000, to be paid at the moment of the registration, a first installment equal to 50% of the remaining tuition fee, to be paid by March 30th, 2024, and a second installment, equal to the remaining part of the tuition fee, to be paid by April 13th, 2024

- The course is limited to 8 participants to guarantee the quality of the tuition. Saturday and Sunday: 5 hours of tuition (9 am 2 pm)
 Tuesday to Friday: 16 hours of use of the facility to be booked at your
- convenience from 9 am to 8 pm
 For students who are unable to utilize their workshop time during the week, we provide the option to carry forward up to a maximum of 32 hours of workshop time after the course concludes.
- · Material Usage: Materials provided are included in the tuition fee. For the personal project, there is an allowance of AED500. The additional cost of the material will be paid separately.
- Project Size Limitation: Maximum dimensions 80cm x 65cm x 35cm. Projects exceeding complexity may be declined or incur extra material charges.
- Consumables like glue and sandpaper are provided by The Makers Society within
- Special hardware like hinges or drawer pulls are to be provided by the student.
- Project Completion: Projects not completed within the 8-week course can be finished using unused time in the workshop up to 32 hours. After that, the access will be at the published rental cost.
- Attendance Policy: Participants are expected to maintain a minimum attendance rate of 80% to complete the course. In case of unavoidable absences, participants may access make-up resources upon request. Excessive unexcused absences, exceeding 20% of the total course duration, may result in the participant being ineligible to receive a completion certificate.
- Code of Conduct: Participants are required to conduct themselves with respect and courtesy towards instructors and peers at all times. Strict adherence to safety protocols and proper handling of tools and equipment are mandatory.
- Privacy Policy: We respect your privacy and are committed to protecting your personal information. Data collected (such as names, contact details, and emergency contact information) is used solely for course management, communication, and emergencies. Personal data will not be shared with third parties without consent, except as required by law. Participants have the right to access, correct, and request the deletion of their data.
