- Understand screws and their use in woodworking.

Week 5: Sanding and Finishing (1 hr 45 mins)

- Discover the importance of sanding in woodworking.
- Learn sanding techniques for a smooth finish.
- Apply wood finishes like paint or oil to the project.

Week 6: Grand Finale - Birdhouse Completion (1 hr 45 mins)

- The final class focuses on completing the wooden project.
- Assemble all components, ensuring a sturdy and functional structure.
- · Decorating and personalizing the project.
- Showcase the completed project and celebrate the achievements with a certificate ceremony.
